

**ANGREB AF CORYNESPORA CASSIICOLA KONSTATETERET I KALANCHOE (LEAF AND STEM SPOT CAUSED BY CORYNESPORA CASSIICOLA).**

The symptoms on kalanchoe plants were dark brown, sunken, necrotic lesions at the stem of the plants. Severely affected plants showed extensive crown rotting. The causal fungal pathogen was isolated on potato dextrose agar (PDA). Based on morphology, the fungus was identified as *Corynespora cassiicola* (Berk. & Curt.) Wei (Ellis and Holliday 1971).
